³³At noon, darkness came over the whole land until three in the afternoon. ³⁴And at three in the afternoon Jesus cried out in a loud voice, "Eloi, Eloi, lema sabachthani?" (which means "My God, my God, why have you forsaken me?"). Mark 16

What do we do with Suffering?

Traditional thought

- a. If God is Great, he must have the power to remove evil.
- b. If God is Good, he must want to remove evil.
- c. Therefore evil must not exist. But it does.

Bible does not shy away from acknowledging this ²³ Awake, Lord! Why do you sleep? Rouse yourself! Do not reject us forever. ²⁴ Why do you hide your face and forget our misery and oppression? Ps 44

But we begin to see it point to the future, to answer the question.

The Bible reframes it

- a. If God is Great, then he can defeat evil. b. If God is Good, then he will defeat evil.
- c. Therefore, God will defeat evil.

The Bible seems to take it further

This is the best of all possible ways to enter the best of all possible worlds.

- a. If God is Great, he must have the power to bring about the best world.
 b. If God is Good, he must want to bring about the best world in the best way.
- c. Therefore allowing evil now must be the best way to bring about the best world.

In order to get to the best world, God needed to allow people to freely choose to love Him.
